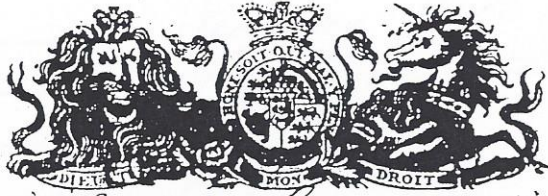

HIS Excellency *Lieutenant General Sir Richard Bourke* Captain General, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Territory of New South Wales and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c. &c. &c.

To all His Majesty's Officers and Ministers of Justice within the Territory of New South Wales and its Dependencies for the time-being; and to all other His Majesty's Subjects whom these Presents may Concern;

GREETING:—

**W**HEREAS *Thomas Kite* late of *Wiltshire* (a description of whose Person is on the back hereof for the greater certainty written,) was Tried and Convicted of

on the *Fifteenth* Day of *January* *London* in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and *Twelve* and *he* the said *Thomas Kite* for his said Offence was adjudged or ordered to be Transported to the said Territory of New South Wales for the Time or Term of *h<sup>w</sup>* Natural Life: AND WHEREAS the said *Thomas Kite* was for said Offence

duly Conveyed and Transported from *London* to, and arrived in the said Territory of New South Wales by the Ship *Sardane - 2 - Walker* Master, in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and *thirteen*.

AND WHEREAS in consideration of the good Conduct of the said *Thomas Kite* since his arrival in the said Territory of New South Wales, I, the said *Lieutenant General Sir Richard Bourke* have thought fit to extend the Royal Mercy to *him* the said *Thomas Kite* and to

REMIT the whole of the Remainder of the Time or Term for which *he* the said *Thomas Kite* hath been so Transported as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE KNOW YE, That I, the said *Lieutenant General Sir Richard Bourke* in virtue and exercise of the power and authority in me, the GOVERNOR of the said Territory of New South Wales as aforesaid, vested by the Commission of his late Majesty King GEORGE THE THIRD, duly made and granted under the Great Seal of Great Britain, in pursuance of the Act of Parliament in such case made and provided, and bearing date at Westminster in the Thirty-first Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, do hereby ABSOLUTELY REMIT the whole of the Time or Term yet to come and unexpired of the Time or Term for which *he* the said *Thomas Kite* was

adjudged, or ordered to be, and hath been Conveyed and Transported to the said Territory of New South Wales as aforesaid; PROVIDED ALWAYS, however, and this Instrument of Remission is made and granted upon the following Condition, that is to say, That the said *Thomas Kite*

do and shall Quit the Colony of New South Wales and its Dependencies at any Time when *he* shall be required by the GOVERNOR so to do: And if the said

*Thomas Kite* shall fail well and truly to keep and perform the said Condition, then this Instrument shall be void and of no effect, and the said *Thomas Kite* shall be exposed to all the Penalties of the Original Sentence.

GIVEN under my Hand and the Seal of the Government of the said Territory of New South Wales, Sydney, this *fourteenth* Day of *November* in the *first* Year of the Reign of His Majesty King *Queen Victoria* and in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven.
